- Sep 2020: UE, R and ZB form administrative writing team
- Nov 2020: Kick off with diverse software experts group
- Feb 2021: Writing workshop with expert group
- Jun 2021: Frist draft
- Feb 2022: Enacted by resolution of the board
- Mid 2022: Accessible via new RSE Portal
- Aug 2022: Available in DE & EN
- Dec 2022: Open Access publication on JuSER
