Toolbox

Research projects in a wide range of scientific disciplines generate data that needs to be managed. With research data management we refer to the handling of research data throughout its entire data lifecycle. This toolbox is intended to provide an **overview of research data management tools** that are available at the Forschungszentrum and that Jülich researchers can provide information on how to use.

In the context of this toolbox research data management incorporates all those processes that fulfil (at least) one data management function. We differentiate the following functions: Data access, discovery, storage, sharing, publishing, metadata management, and version control. Two additional categories give an overview of tools for creating data management plans and for data and lab management. The **tools can be filtered** according to functionality or to organisational units respectively.





RDM Challenge Projects

Many researchers, programmers and experts in research data management (RDM) at Forschungszentrum Jülich have rich knowledge and experience in the operation of complex infrastructure and data resources - and in creating scientific workflows that move data from one resource to another or that make it FAIR. In 2021 the Jülich board of directors decided to initiate three rounds of RDM challenges (one each year) to give further

impulses and to interconnect RDM people and expertise. For the first call six project proposals were selected for funding. These challenge projects work towards RDM goals such as:

- · Planning of RDM tasks to make data FAIR
- . Building, extending, connecting data infrastructure and workflows
- · Integrating RDM and data analytics (services)
- · RDM training and competence building

The proposal TEMPLATE for the 3rd funding round of the Jülich RDM Challenges Call and the call are now also available in the funding section.





Challenges prioritise relationships and people (IT isn't funded)

- forming teams that (so far) haven't worked together
- JCNS-TA-IT (for example) works for free as an RDM partner for other institutes
- output/report of challenges is public, workshops are open to all at Jülich

Fruitful connections between RDM challenges and other projects, e.g. NFDI

- make developments from other projects useful at Jülich, too
- try something at Jülich which you want to transfer to other projects

Good practice, provenance, reproducibility

- F.A.I.R.: Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Re-usable data
- do good and talk about it: Helmholtz, fdm.NRW, research data days, etc..
