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Correction: Fractionation of lignocellulosic biomass using the OrganoCat process

The authors note that the values for annual earnings and the break-even point concept have been reproduced incorrectly in the conclusion section. The correct data are those quoted on page 5 (second column, and in Fig. 4) of the published paper.

Hence, the correct version of the respective sentence in the conclusion should read:

Thus, the annual earnings increase from 2.4 to 4.4 Mio US\$ y⁻¹ and the process could become profitable at a lignin price of ~90 US\$ t⁻¹ (at a moderate annual capacity of 50 000 t of wood).
