One of the largest research institutions in Europe

- National research center in Germany
- 11 institutes > 7,000 employees
- Interdisciplinary research in energy, information, and bioeconomy

Jülich Supercomputing Centre

Will become the host of an exascale computer in 2023

- The Institute for Advanced Simulations (IAS) is responsible for HPC
 - Jülich Supercomputing Centre (JSC) is the largest IAS institute
 - It operates supercomputers of the highest performance class



• Other institutions use the supercomputers for applications such as climate research, quantum technologies or medicine
